In other words, for May 4th you would leave your car at TRELAWNYD in the morning and are taken to the start at BASINGWERK enabling you to walk back to your car. At the end of the first day we will inform everyone what will happen on the following day, whether it will be a car share or the use of public transport. You are of course welcome to make your own arrangements.

****Transport for each day is dependant on whether we use public transport or our own vehicles. On the first day, although we start from Basingwerk Abbey, we park our cars at Trelawnyd so that we can walk back to them. We suggest if you share a car that you drop off any passengers at the beginning of the walk (Basingwerk Abbey) before proceeding to Trelawnyd for the 'meet at' time indicated so that we can get the drivers back to the start in good time.**
